Dear Parents/Guardians,

St Clare's College is holding its Annual Athletics Carnival on Friday 26 July 2019. The venue is the **ES Marks Athletics Field**, located on the corner of Boronia St & Anzac Parade, Kensington. The carnival day is a **compulsory school day** for all students.

The carnival will commence at 8:30am sharp and conclude by approximately 2:30pm. **Students will make their own way to and from the venue.** It is expected that all students will arrive at the athletics field **no later than 8.10am**. Roll call will take place at 8:15 am. If your daughter is sick on the day, it is expected that a phone call be made to the College on the morning of the carnival. A doctor's certificate will need to be presented to the Homeroom teacher on her return to school. Any student failing to attend the day without a certificate will receive a detention.

It is essential that all students bring the necessary sun protection such as sunscreen, hat, House coloured shirts and sunglasses. Students may wear casual clothes to the carnival, provided they wear something in House colours and appropriate for a College Athletics Carnival. Limited canteen facilities will be available on the day. However, the girls are encouraged to bring their own lunches and plenty of fluids to drink.

An announcement will appear on the College web page by 6:30am, also an SMS will be sent to parents and a notice placed on Sentral **only** if the carnival is to be cancelled. If the Carnival is cancelled, students are expected to be at school at the normal time in full school uniform, ready for **Friday** classes.

This is considered a **normal** school day, students are expected to stay at the venue until the end of the carnival. **No student will be dismissed early.**
