- 10.30 Mass
- 11.40 Walk back to School
- 11.45 BBQ lunch
- 12.15 Walk to Event Cinema Bondi Junction

- 2:45 Walk back to school and dismissal

Students are expected to come to school in **FULL COLLEGE UNIFORM**, including their blazer. Students will walk to the Church in their Homeroom groups with their Homeroom Teacher and House Dean to supervise them. Additional teachers will be positioned at intersections to ensure the safe crossing of roads. At the conclusion of the mass, the College community will continue celebrations with an organised lunch at school.
