COVID-19 Update as of 19 August 2020

Thank you for your patience as we continue to navigate the ever changing guidelines which aim to protect the health and safety of everyone in our community to the best of our ability. Our school remains safe, however, we must remain vigilant as a community.

Many of you would have seen that there have been some changes to the guidelines impacting the operations at our school and the safety and hygiene measures in place at schools in NSW.

Most importantly, if your child is unwell (even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms) they should **NOT** be attending school. In accordance with advice from NSW Health, if your daughter attends school and becomes ill or presents with flu-like symptoms we will request that you collect them from the school office.

NSW Health have also requested that anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms, should be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics. More information can be found at [NSW Health](#).

Any students with flu-like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school. This is generally in the form of a text message and we kindly ask that you take a screenshot and email this through to info@stclares.catholic.edu.au
