Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your child will be participating in the compulsory Year 7 Camp **10-12 MARCH 2021**. Students will participate in a range of activities over the course of the camp including surfing, kayaking, high ropes, drop pole and more. Activities are run by qualified staff at Collaroy Convention Centre and students will be accompanied by teachers. These activities, along with discussions held throughout the camp, will help develop the students capacity for resilience, respect and responsibility.

Students will leave for Collaroy Conference Centre, Collaroy Beach at **8.45am**, on Wednesday 10th March and will return by **3pm** on Friday 12th March. The students will be travelling by Private Coach and are to meet the supervising teachers at the College Basketball Courts, Church Street Gates no later than **8:15 am**. **As per the current NSW COVID-19 restrictions, it is compulsory that ALL students will be required to wear a face mask for all bus trips during the camp. Students are to provide their own face mask(s).** The camp will be led by Mrs Moore.

The cost of the camp is covered through the Excursion Levy and all meals are provided by the venue.

It is an expectation that students wear appropriate casual clothing to complete activities and a detailed list is provided.

FINAL REMINDER FOR CAMP

FOR STUDENTS:

1. Clothing **MUST** be appropriate for a school event. No singlet tops, very short shorts, or revealing clothing. Sports/running shoes are required for all outdoor activities. Clothing must provide adequate sun protection and coverage for activities requiring the use of harnesses.
2. You must have a **HAT, WATER BOTTLE** and be wearing sunscreen at all outdoor activities.
3. **A sleeping bag, pillow and single bed sheet are required.**
4. A small amount of snack food is permitted; no NUT products, soft drinks or sport/energy drinks. Students are responsible for the daily clean up of cabins.
5. **Students are to provide their own face mask(s) for all bus transportation during Camp. Students are also encouraged to bring their own personal hand sanitiser and supply their own personal soap for bathroom usage in accomodation.**
6. **NO DIGITAL DEVICES** - no exceptions. This includes mobile phones.
7. Bring your sense of adventure and willingness to have fun!

FOR PARENTS:

Students are required to be at the Church St entrance gates on Wednesday 10th March no later than 8:15 am. We ask parents that upon drop off on Wednesday, that you do not enter onto the college basketball court, or wait with your daughter as this causes significant congestion, and poses a WHS risk. The bus will leave promptly at 8:45am. Please ensure your daughter is collected promptly on Friday afternoon. We expect to arrive back at the college by 3pm.

CAMP SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

Clothing:

- Underwear
- Socks (*1 pair per day plus an extra pair*)
- Swimmers - St Clare's College one piece (or similar one-piece) costume
- Rash shirt/Board shorts (*optional*)
- Shorts
- Tights
- T-shirts
- Jumper
- Tracksuit pants
- Shoes (*2 pairs*)

Bedding:

- Pillow
- Sleeping bag
- Single bed fitted sheet
- Towel x 2 (*Shower + Beach*)

Toiletries:

- Toothbrush
- Tooth paste
- Hair brush
- Personal soap for shower
- Any required Medications (*to be handed up to Teaching staff for management/distribution*)

Other:

- Face Mask for bus

Do Not Bring:
